

The OCM BOCES Adult Education program has been a mainstay in the Liverpool community for over 35+ years. The training site was originally located on Crown Road and moved to a state-of-the-art facility at 110 Elwood Davis Road in 2016.

With the recent boom in the CNY labor demand, local trades companies and unions continue to rely on the in-depth training students receive in Construction Technology, Electrical Maintenance, Welding and HVAC/R. Full time training is offered at the Main Campus in Liverpool in all four disciplines on 6-month cycles. Students can start in August or February and typically attend from 8 AM-3:30 PM. Upon completion of the 5-month training in their labs and classrooms, students must complete a one-month internship in their related field of study.

Recent statistics indicate job placement rates in all four programs ranging from 92%-100%. There is a huge demand for skilled trades people in Central New York and the OCM BOCES Adult Education program continues to produce qualified technicians to enter the workforce as industry leaders!

Instructors work with their respective industry partners to ensure that students work with state-of-the art equipment and are afforded the opportunity to earn specific industry related certifications upon completion of the program.

All of the full-time programs offered at OCM BOCES Adult Education qualify for federal financial aid through FAFSA. Prospective students must have a high school diploma or high equivalency diploma to qualify. The student services division works with employers and several community agencies to assist with additional tuition assistance.

If you are interested in learning more, OCM BOCES offers an open house every Thursday, promptly at 1:00 PM at their Main Campus-110 Elwood Davis Road (just off 7th North Street). 





## Native Plants: What Are They?

Have you ever wondered what the term, “native” means when referring to plants? Native to what region? A native plant may not be “native” to Central New York. In, *Native Plants of the Northeast, A Guide for Gardening and Conservation*, by Donald J. Leopold: “a native plant can be trees, shrubs, and herbaceous species (including wildflowers, grasses, and ferns.)”

One such native wildflower is *Echinacea purpurea*, from the family Asteraceae. You may have seen this flower growing in many of your neighbors’ gardens or even in your own garden. Commonly called purple coneflower, they grow quite easily here in CNY. The question is are they considered a native plant? The short answer is, yes, but it is not native to CNY. The Cornell Botanic Gardens ([cornellbotanicgardens.org](http://cornellbotanicgardens.org)) says, that purple coneflower is native to the North American tallgrass prairies and the great plains.

So, we can understand native plants to be: the indigenous terrestrial and aquatic species that have evolved and occur naturally in a particular region, ecosystem, or habitat , according to the USDA US Forest Service ([fs.usda.gov](http://fs.usda.gov)). Thus, species native to North America are generally recognized as plants that were growing on the continent prior to European settlement. Some examples include: conifer trees, hardwood, trees, and, shrubs, grasses , forbs, and others. ([fs.usda.gov](http://fs.usda.gov))
