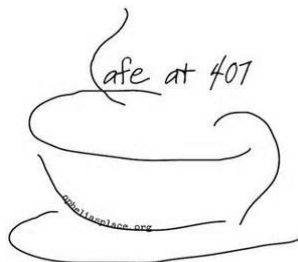

- 4) Confirm Installation Day Plan – even the smallest of details matter. Before installation have the discussion about furniture, arrival times, number of days, pets, etc.
- 5) Clear Project Completion Steps – know who does what and when the project is over.... what's the providers commitment to satisfaction now and in the future?

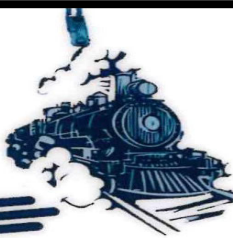

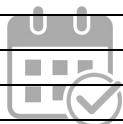

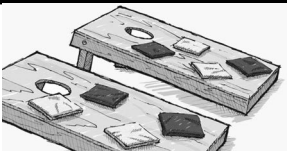
